DEFENSE TRANSFORMATION INSTITUTE

The Texas Research and Technology Foundation (TRTF), in coordination with the City's Economic Development Department, established the DTI in July 2004 to serve as a proactive intermediary with the active military installations in leveraging their military assets.

DTI is a non-profit single member L.L.C. formed under the Texas Research and Technology Foundation.

VISION

DTI seeks to become a nationally recognized authority in developing innovative and successful public-private and public-public partnership models between the military and communities.

MISSION

DTI serves as the primary intermediary for leveraging assets at and around active military installations in San Antonio (e.g., people, land, facilities, laboratories, research, training, etc.) to create value for the community and the military.

GOALS

- ❖ Help the City promote economic development on and around military bases.
- ❖ Enhance the military value of local missions.
- ❖ Reduce military installation management costs.
- ❖ Accelerate the construction of new base facilities for military missions.
- ❖ Leverage military assets and capabilities through enhanced community partnerships.

STRATEGIES

- ❖ Baseline marketable military assets.
- ❖ Catalog existing partnership agreements.
- ❖ Survey unfunded military requirements.
- ❖ Market San Antonio's military assets at trade shows, conferences, web site, etc.
- ❖ Facilitate public-private, and public-public partnerships leveraging military assets.
- ❖ Host conferences and training forums.



DTI INITIATIVES

- Executed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City of San Antonio recognizing DTI as the City's intermediary for leveraging military assets at local bases.
- Signed a Master CRADA with the Army Clinical Investigation Regulatory Office at Fort Sam Houston to leverage the Army's medical research capabilities.
- Partnering with the State of Texas to accelerate the construction of new facilities on military bases, particularly those receiving new missions and people as a result of BRAC.
- Hosted a conference on military-community partnership models in San Antonio in October 2006.
- Seeking to establish a DoD Center of Excellence on military-community partnership models at Fort Sam Houston.
- Published a Texas Issue of the *Defense Transformation Magazine* in October 2006.
- Partnering with the Army Installation Command to create a Center of Excellence on Installation Management.
